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## SUMMER 2004 DUES & TUITION

**DUES are required for all fencers.** Help support classical fencing in Salem by keeping your dues current. Dues must be paid no later than the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month – preferably sooner. Dues are not refundable. Pay for several months at once or pay as you go – *you pick the plan that fits your budget.*

- ☐ **\$30 Monthly dues** – Pay monthly. *Good choice if you just want to try things out.*
  - ☐ **\$85 Quarterly dues** – 3 months of fencing. *Save \$5. Great option for beginning students!*
  - ☐ **\$170 Semi-annual dues** – 6 months of fencing. *Save \$10.*
  - ☐ **\$330 Annual dues** – Get 12 months of fencing for the price of eleven! *Save \$30.*
  - ☐ **\_\_\_\_\_ Donation** – Always welcome! (Donations are tax-deductible – dues and tuition are not.)
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**TUITION** – Tuition is non-refundable. If you drop a class due to illness or injury, we will issue a credit for the unused portion of your tuition. All classes will be held at 354 Belmont Street NE in Salem.

- ☐ **\$50+dues Introductory Foil Fencing I – Wednesdays** – 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. – Mr. Heggen  
May 26 – August 25, 2004. *Perfect for students on summer break!* 14 weeks of instruction, 28 hours total. Includes use of fencing equipment. No experience needed. Minimum age: 12 years.
- ☐ **\$50+dues Introductory Foil Fencing I – Wednesdays** – 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. – Mr. Heggen  
May 26 – August 25, 2004. 14 weeks of instruction, 28 hours total. Includes use of fencing equipment. No experience needed. Minimum age: 12 years.
- ☐ **\$50+dues Introductory Foil Fencing II – Tuesdays** – 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. – Mr. Villarreal  
May 25 – August 24, 2004. 14 weeks of instruction, 28 hours total. Includes use of fencing equipment. **Prerequisite:** *Introductory Foil Fencing I*. Requires at least **one additional hour each week** spent fencing in the studio. Minimum age: 12 years.
- ☐ **\$50+dues Introductory Foil Fencing II – Thursdays** – 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. – Mr. Heggen  
May 27 – August 26, 2004. 14 weeks of instruction, 28 hours total. Includes use of fencing equipment. **Prerequisite:** *Introductory Foil Fencing I*. Requires at least **one additional hour each week** spent fencing in the studio. Minimum age: 12 years.
- ☐ **\$40+dues Intermediate Foil (Defense) – Thursdays** – 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. – Mr. Heggen  
May 27 – August 26, 2004. 14 weeks of instruction, 28 hours total. See course description for equipment requirements. **Prerequisites:** *Introductory Foil Fencing II*, plus at least one semester of additional fencing. Requires at least **one additional hour each week** spent fencing in the studio. Minimum age: **14 years** (or instructor approval).
- ☐ **\$0+dues No class option** – For fencers who have taken *Introductory Foil Fencing I* (or the equivalent) and just wish to fence at the studio without taking a class this session.
